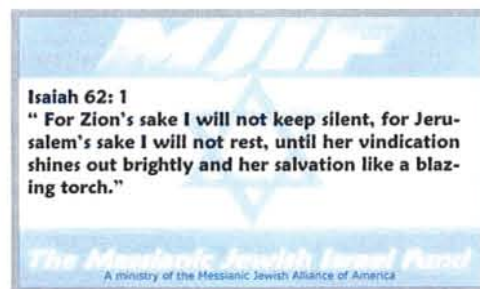

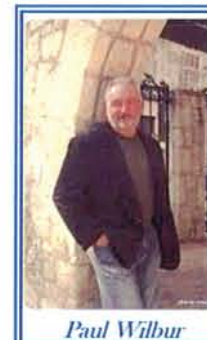


Rabbi Walker
